2024 Music Scholarship Entry Form

VECCA is awarding a scholarship up to \$1,000.

Applicants must be graduating Shenandoah County public, private, or home-schooled students, who demonstrate dedication to their education in pursuing a degree related to Music or similar major, with the intent of either teaching or pursuing a professional career in that field. Please submit the completed application along with the following: 1) a resume of participation in the music program at your school, including District competitions, Chorus, Marching Band, Solo and Ensemble, Regional and State competitions, as well as any related awards; 2) two letters of recommendation, one each from a music teacher and another academic teacher; 3) your personal statement, approximately one typed page (double-spaced), concerning the importance of music in your life to date and in the future (please include your college/major plans); 4) an audition CD or digital link with 3 to 5 minutes sharing your musical skills; and 5) a current photo of yourself. Home-schooled students should use their private music instructor and another adult, familiar with their musical ability as references. Live auditions may be requested.

Deadline for submission is April 6, 2024.
